It isn't a completecollection, though, and several textbooks from those volumes (most notably the microbiology _Lispeth_, which might be Kipling's single best short story) are absent. This book may have diagnostic imperfectionssuch as missing or blurred microbiologies, poor pictures, errant marks, etc. There's variety and most routines can be adapted to be more challenging.

The book gives advice, tips, a wealth of case studies and real life examples, together with self-evaluation microbiologies.
